Full Moon in Capricorn July 19

July Themes

Two planets bring the light and some grist in two phases this month



1. Mercury and Venus

July brings Mercury & Venus to both Gemini and then Cancer – this sets the tone for more Green Days this month, thank goodness.

Even though Mercury and Venus can bring playfulness and joy into our lives when they move through Gemini, the real fun begins after July 15th when Venus comes out of the rays of the Sun and becomes visible for the first time in

a while. Venus can now help us all access an inner joy in a new way ~ and when we get a brighter moon around July 19, we end up getting some pretty rockin' Green Days this month where the Moon is influenced by either the positive guiding planets of Venus, Mercury or Jupiter for different flavor Green Days.

June 27 - July 11 Mercury is in Gemini

A short visit for the planet that brings us fun and child-like perspective in our lives. Use these first few weeks of July to get outside every day and just look at the wonder of the world, be it the lady bugs or how water moves along a creek. Walking, hiking or sitting in green environments are particular rewarding during this period of time.

July 11 - July 26 Mercury in Cancer

Mercury swims through the Crab constellation of water, couple this with Venus being in the SAME constellation of Cancer July 7 – July 31 and this sets the tone for some VERY functional Green Days when the Moon is in Capricorn, the sign of work and integrating the spiritual into physical form.

2. Saturn and Mars

Saturn and Mars return to being together in Scorpio (See July 13 – September 17 below)

It was both Mars and Saturn retrograding in Scorpio along with Jupiter getting very close to Rahu that brought more violent events to bear, and more fires in the hotter zones of the world, more media coverage of the polluted waters, like in Rio (if you do not know about how the polluted waters of the bay have been infecting and killing children for decades, learn more here

July 13 – September 17 Mars and Saturn rumble again in Scorpio

For another time this year, the planets of quick karmas, Mars, and slow-building something great, Saturn (and sometimes chronic issues of pain or suffering) are together in Scorpio.

At least this time both planets will not be retrograding like they were in June. These are the conditions which give us those SPECIAL YELLOW DAYS that were added to the calendar this year.

Look for those Yellow Days to be a mixture of 'hurry up and impatience' and 'obstacles' in the way which will eventually make what you are doing better.

Those Yellow Days will be about what comes from building patience and perseverance.

3. More good news: Remember too, that July has only one retrograde planet all month long - Saturn in Scorpio.

July – Some Daily Highlights 2016

Saturday July 2

Moon in Taurus, waning in light on the 13th day of waning toward a New Moon.

Rohini Moon and the Moon brushes close to Aldebaran the Red eye of the bull in Taurus, and the fertile energy of the zodiac. This moon connects with creativity, but since it is waning in light, this is a time to be readying the soil and your body and your mind for the New Moon in just a few days.

Exfoliate! to reveal fresh healthy skin that will allow your body to absorb healing oils when you massage it into your skin.

Begin planning any house plant transplants, or landscaping and garden projects to begin on or after July 4 or 5th.

Sunday July 3 Red Day

It's a Red Day because the Moon is one day before new, but the Moon is in Gemini with Mercury, the Sun and Venus today. So, savor a quiet night in try singing out loud or a quiet game that builds concentration like building card houses or Jenga. That is a great way to harness the energy of the day and develop fine motor movement that is called for today. Sewing, hemming, or adding a flourish to some of your favorite clothes is another way you might spend the evening.

Try not to work out too hard today, pace yourself and make sure you have proper electrolytes, aka potassium and magnesium.

Monday July 4 Mild Green Day and New Moon in Gemini

It is a Mild Green Day because Mercury, Venus, Sun and Moon are all in a Mercury sign, and the sign of the twins.

The New Moon is at 11:01 UTC (4:01 am Pacific Time, 7:01 am ET).

Mercury, the planet of play, communication, commerce and learning brings delight with the little details of life, like the wonder of nature and word play because it is in its own sign this month.

The New Moon is in the Orion constellation (since Ardra in Vedic Astrology is the star Betelgeuse). This is a bold, brash and intense section of sky and is not normally a Green Day at all, but because we have the Moon with new light and with Venus and Mercury for the first time out of Saturn's glance since May, I wanted to give this day an honorable mention.

Since this new moon is connected with such a fierce desire for expansion, the first few weeks of July will have most of us working hard toward a goal, and as long as you pay attention to the details, you will be successful.

July 7, 8 & 9 Yellow Days

The Moon is in Leo with Jupiter and the shadow energy of Rahu for two and half days. If you are a speaker, then you can get the word out about leadership and make more of a splash on these kind of days.

Thursday July 7 Yellow Day and the day that Venus moves into the constellation of Cancer. This is a regal Moon day, it's a Jupiter Moon day. The Moon is close to Regulus the kingly red star in Leo.

Leadership is the theme of the day, but in a way where you show others that you can 'let go' and show kindness and compassion – that is the best form of leadership.

Friday July 8 Yellow Day

A somewhat more typical Yellow Day. Depending on your time zone, expect to work-around complications, find back road routes around traffic jams, surprises or random obstacles or distractions

today. At least it is not a regular work day for most. Probably not the best errand day. (For instance, the complication hits later in the day for Pacific Time zone 4:39 pm PT - 10:39 pm PT when the Moon crosses the shadow planet's mark in the sky. Be careful driving or what you say during that time zone.)

Saturday July 9 Yellow Day

A bit of a wild Yellow Day which could be filled with adventure, but may not be the safest day for bungee jumping.

This Sun-Moon relationship today sets the conditions for creating community and influence and connecting on a personal level as well as charity work and giving back. You may connect with coworkers or those in your industry, especially if it is a volunteer event which helps others.

Even though that is not a typical Yellow Day activity, a fun social outing or charity work can be rewarding today, just keep it safe!

Still probably not the best errand day.

Friday July 15 Yellow Day

This is the new kind of Yellow Day that brings a combination of blind faith and tendency of not seeing the trees through the forest. There might be some 'unexpected' pressure or issue arise today, which you might admit to yourself you suspected might happen.

Full Moon in Capricorn July 19

The moon becomes full in Capricorn at 22:57 UTC (3:57 pm PT, 6:57 pm ET).

Since this is the universal sign of work, productivity, moving idea and projects forward and integrating spiritual principles into everyday life – the strides you make over the next two weeks will be both practical and spiritually significant to you.

The lunar mansion is a lucky or stable one, called Utttara Ashada, and is close to the star Vega, which was our North Star many thousands of years ago, and will be again in the year 14,000.

Wednesday July 20 Green Day

True Green Day, Type IV, moveable auspices.

Today the Moon has movement to it and is blessed with both Venus and Mercury shining goodness on to it. Seize opportunities to run errands, move things around, transplant plants, or make major changes – the changes will be good.

• An extra special auspicious window begins the day – again as long as the focus or project is for a higher good and not to only line your pockets the endeavor will be a stellar success.

Thursday July 21 Green Day Type IV moveable day ~

Today brings a little more structure to the changes. Sure it is a good day for moving your home or office or moving things around in your routine, but it is as if a drum beat were moving you along. You can jam and feel the vibrations of a greater cause waving through you – connect with music, sound and rhythms today to infuse your day with even more joy!

Friday July 29 The Moon is in Taurus very close to Aldebaran. It is a potential Yellow Day because the Moon is opposite Mars and Saturn but the auspicious Moon in Rohini softens the day, and the intensity that was here in June because both Mars and Saturn were retrograde is better this month.

Question of the day: What is it you are working toward? Peace, ease, purpose filled work or freedom? Let that answer direct your actions for the day.

Saturday July 30 Look to the sky! Mercury is close to the kingly star Regulus in Leo tonight.

Just to remind you the theme of July reminds you that you can make a difference.
